### Admission thro Management Quota:

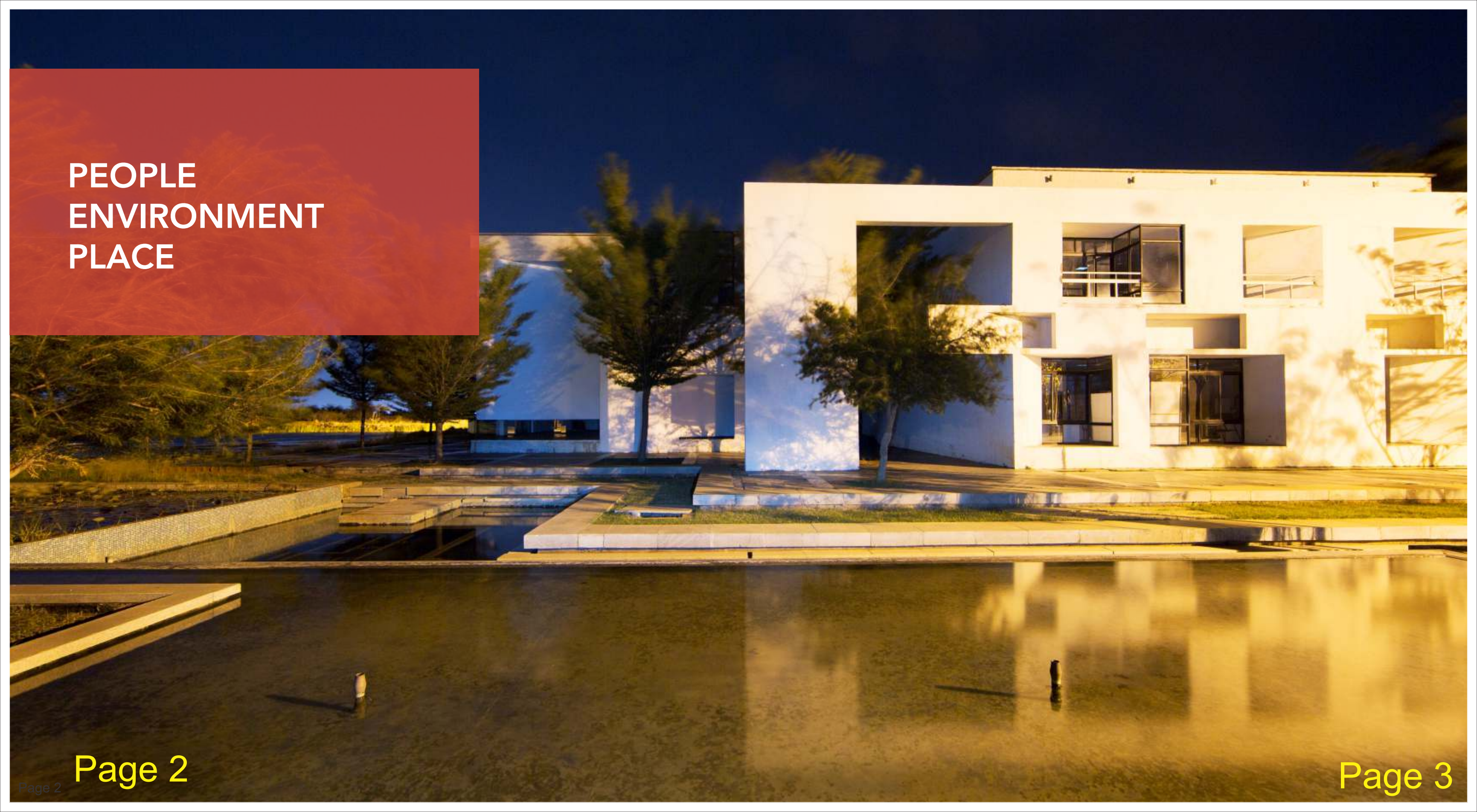

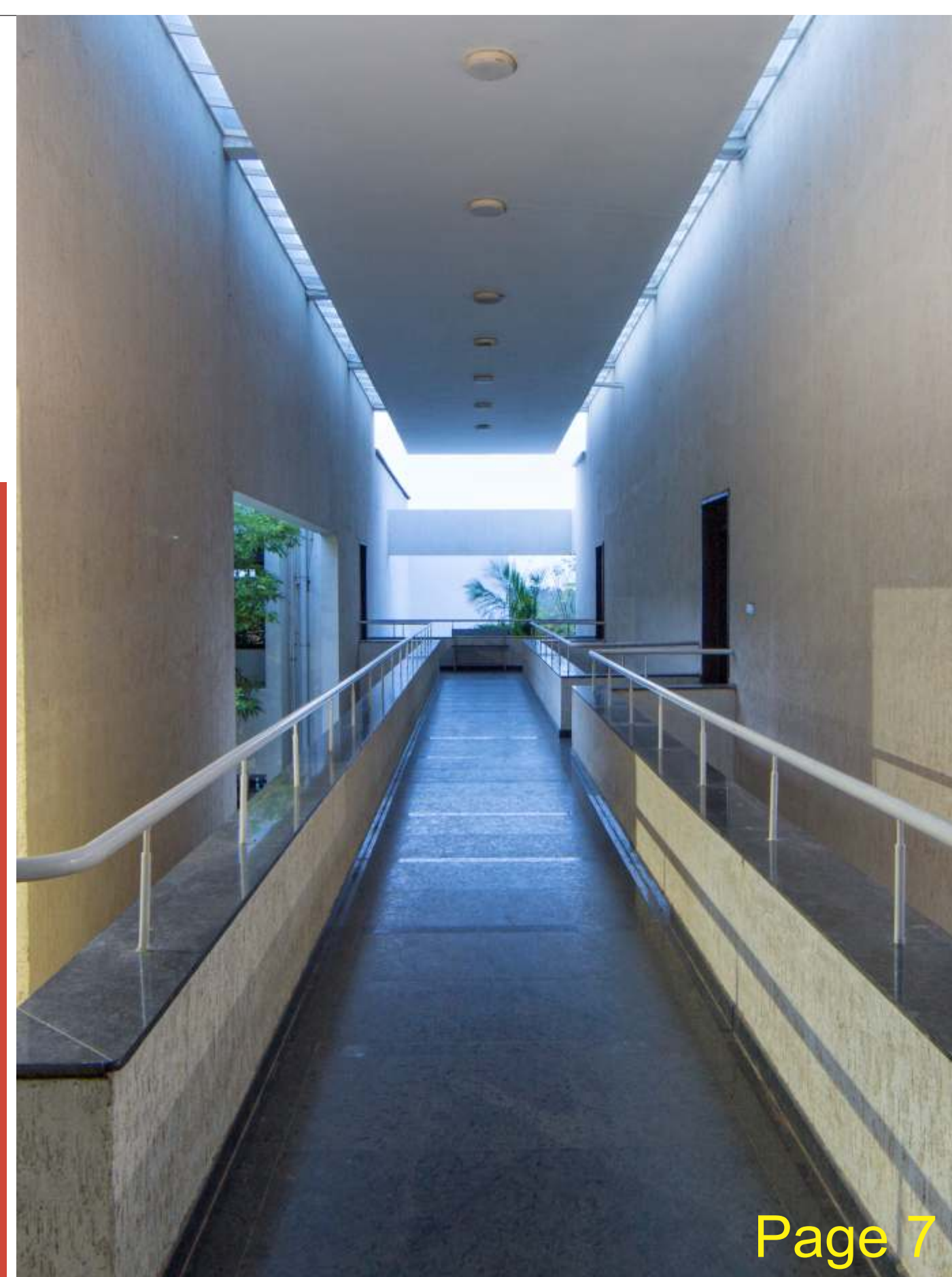


## THE RIGHT ENVIRONMENT
